SELECTION PROCESS

The exchange proposals will be selected on an ongoing basis. Kindly note that the proposed topics should have an international scope of interest.

Up to 2 lecturers per university can be accepted. Some of specific lecturing areas where lecturers are sought (application in other areas are also accepted):

- Innovation and Entrepreneurship.
- Strategic Management (strategy formulation, implementation, control, strategic CSR...).
- Advanced Macroeconomics.
