#### PFI Scholarship Idea & Goals

Our goal is to motivate students at Czech universities to earn their master's degree abroad, broaden their educational horizons and experiences and to return to the Czech Republic and strengthen the community of experts locally.



The financial support provided to a selected student shall focus mainly on tuition fees and/or coverage of living expenses that are directly connected with studies abroad.

We wish to offer the selected students attractive working possibilities in the Czech Republic after their graduation from leading universities, in conjunction with our current and prospective partner institutions and / or sponsors.

The aim is to support the first outgoing student in 2024.

#### Students

PFI together with its partners aims to enable a student to study master's program at their chosen university abroad.

The amount of financial support will depend on a financial overview prepared by candidates demonstrating their economic situation and funds, reasonably necessary for their study abroad.

The support will be disbursed in parts before the start of each semester.

Selected and successful students will also become our partners by sharing their experience with the other candidates, helping an application process further on and further promoting the PFI Scholarship Program.

## Prerequisites

Citizenship of the Czech Republic

Age below 26 (at the time of the deadline for submission of application)

Submission of application or admission<sup>1</sup> to a leading university chosen by a candidate<sup>2</sup>

Shortage of funds arising from student's economic situation

<sup>1</sup> Confirmation of admission will be necessary later in the selection process.

<sup>2</sup> The university must be in the top 100 in the current Shanghai Ranking's Global Ranking, U.S. News Global Rankings or QS World University Rankings.





## Selection Procedure

Prague Finance Institute

#### 1st round

submission of the application consisting of:

- CV in English language
- Motivational letter in written or video form in English language – we are keen to hear, among other things, what do you wish to study and why; what are your career plans, etc.
- Academic results for 2 last years of study
- Financial plan of expected expenses
- Proof of limiting/challenging economic situation

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> round

interview with the Selection Committee (representatives of donors and selected PFI BoD Members)

Motivation (with emphasis on the potential of the candidate's return to the Czech Republic) and prior academic results

2

Choice of university and program

3

Social situation
